The Devil's Tasting Note

Refreshing, rich and exotic. This wine treats the taste buds with its seductive flavors, tempting, nay, taunting the sole for just one more sip. It is a sin not to finish this bottle as the apricot, peach and spice wrap a backbone of flavor around you palate, in a wine that sparks your senses and stirs the dark side to indulge. This wine is made to consume within 12 months from release in October 2010, however will continue to develop and enrich if cellaring occurs.

Winemaking Notes ~ Whole bunch pressing over five hours to maintain flavor intensity was a crucial step in the winemaking process. The wine was cool-fermented over two weeks in temperature controlled stainless steel tanks. No malolactic occurred.

The purity of our fruit meant no fining was needed. The wine was cold stabilized and sterile filtered using cross flow filtration prior to bottling.
